

Extended Day at Kuss

The Matthew J. Kuss Middle School was one of the first of ten schools in the state to take part in the Expanded Learning Time Initiative (ELT) beginning in September 2006. Kuss is one of three schools in the Fall River public schools district to take part in this grant. As a result students have an additional eight hours in their school week to enhance their academic subjects and participate in new electives and cultural programs. Students have an additional 1.5 hours of English literacy instruction, 1.5 hours of math instruction and 1.5 hours of science instruction per week. Students participate an additional three hours of elective choices. The school day is from 7:15-3:27.

Students at Kuss have the opportunity to choose from a variety of electives including: Forensics, Ham Radio, Martial Arts, Intramurals, Painting, Band, CPR and First Aid, Theater, Guitar, Hip Hop, Yearbook, Traveling the World and Swimming, to name a few.
